This document lists, by category, outstanding or unresolved issues that were known as of the MOS 4.3.6-GA release date.

Address book

- Deleted contact appears in "Edit Group" dialog box. "Invalid contact index" displays when you click "Ok". This issue no longer appears after logout/ login. (56793)
- u The WebMail address book can crash if patch E4_3_CE42_US_3 is installed and named brands are present for delegated domains. (57042)

Admind

- u Cannot import exceptions to single users. (57034)
- Upgrading systems in a N+1 cluster requires that those systems are first removed from the cluster. In certain circumstances, the licenses will be revoked from a system once de-clustered as they are not valid for that node. First applying the correct licenses for that node may mitigate the issue. (57079)

Branding

"ERROR file too large" while publishing the brand containing chinese locale.

Calendar

- ^u The "Repeat until" date is changed after saving the event. This can lead to a repeated event's last instance not appearing in a user's calendar if they are in a different timezone. (56799)
- In calendar when Time Mode = 24 hrs and Day spans from 0 to 24 hrs, new event created at 0:00-1:00 appears twice in "Horizontal Week View". Once on previous day after 23:00 hr cell and another at correct place at 0:00 cell. (56813)
- u Event update by person with whom the calendar is shared with write access doesn't work as expected. (56814)

- u Repeated event can't be viewed by person with whom the calendar is shared if the user is given read/write permission. (56816)
- u When owner deletes the event from calendar, the notification is not sent to attendees and also event from attendees's calendar is not deleted. (56851)
- u Unable to open/download attachment from any event instance belonging to repeating events in CE. (56981)
- u Calender CE uses local machine time to decide age of an event. (56990)

CLI

u "MON SETTHRESH SYSTEM.NTP*RESP 0" does not disable "System Alert: External NTP Service check failed" alerts. (56951)

Console

u The "MON Clear" command doesn't clear the alerts returned by "MON Status". (57087)

Enterprise UI

u Automatic word wrap is not operating correctly. (52549)

Fastpath

u When recipient domain is not resolvable, the mail is delivered to user on local machine. (57040)

Filter

 A mail going through the redirect filter also sends a copy to original destination. The redirection works but you also receive a copy in original destination mailbox. (57023)

Hardware

u "stat get system.voltage" command does not work. (56891)

Installer

u Installer errors: Cannot find kickstart file on CDROM attached via USB. (57077)

WebMail

Users are not displayed in the Sharing Control section of the UI when they have been enabled with read or write permissions. This occurs with IE9 only. (56379)

- Error after double-clicking checkbox in sharing controls. Once user double clicks any of the check box under Options" -> "SharingControls", subsequent single/double click on those check boxes will result in checkbox getting converted to text box. (56809)
- ^u If the user is logged into a portal page, logging out redirects to the respective login page of webmail edition and not to the portal page login. (56944)
- "No conflict" alert is shown when creating an all day event, although there exist a regular event on the same day. (56954)
- u Signature is displayed incorrectly above compose window in IE8. (57003)
- u If a user with auto reply enabled receives an e-mail which has the "Reply-to" header split over more than one line then the user can receive a non-delivery report relating to the auto reply. (57051)
- ^u In certain circumstances the display name is not displayed correctly when a reply is sent from WebMail to Mac OSX. (57084)
- u All day event cannot be changed to event less than All day. (57088)
